**5 NEW APPLICATION HACKNEY CARRIAGE/PRIVATE HIRE DRIVER'S LICENCE (REF: CD)**

A report was presented to the Committee in relation to a new application for a Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Driver's Licence (Ref: CD).

Members were informed that in making their application, the Applicant failed to declare three offences which were subsequently confirmed on their Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check.
